Several months ago we were contacted by the Virginia Range Wildlife Protection Association (VRWPA) in regards to the stray horses at Washoe Lake State Park. Like us, they were concerned with these horses crossing the roads and becoming a further public safety concern. VRWPA offered to utilize their funds to fix the existing fencing and install several areas of new fencing. This project was completed by Modern Land and Development faster than anticipated. We now have steel corner braces and a sturdy fence in areas where the horses typically cross the road and near blind corners. We are very appreciative of the hard work and generosity of the VRWPA in our efforts to help mitigate this public safety issue.
